- We are pleased to say St Bart's is now usually open on **Mondays 10am-12noon & Thursdays 2pm-4pm** to collect food parcels (excluding bank holidays).
- On your second visit please bring some form of ID with your name and address on (unless of NFA), evidence of any benefits you may be on (unless you have a direct referral from an appropriate body e.g. Social Services) and evidence of any school-age children in the household so we can newly or re-register you. (The card stamping system of old is no longer operational.) All details taken will be held securely on file as per GDPR guidelines.
- Please follow any instructions for safe visiting.
- It is normal to have no more than one food parcel per week. Please remember our service is for people in genuine financial need and has never been intended as a long term provision, so you are encouraged to use it sparingly. We will try to accommodate any dietary needs to the best of our ability.
- Please bring bags for your food with you.
- After 12 visits we will reassess how things are going; we may be able to signpost you for further help at this point (if not before) e.g. to the CAB.
